We look forward to welcoming all new students and their families, as they begin their educational journey with us at St. Dominic's Primary School, Camberwell East.




### **Semester 1 Reports & Student-Led Conferences**

- We have a staff Concert Team and we also invite willing parents to support. Let us know if you would like to be part of our Concert preparation this term!






This session will focus on our personalised pathways and transitior from Primary School. Students are encouraged to attend.
