It has given our Italian classroom a festive feel in anticipation of our Festa on March 2nd....



Audiri is a free app which supports more immediate, school/level-wide communication.

**We use this app for communicating from the school to families for instant messages, school calendar.

Operoo is an electronic form system that automatically collates medical and emergency details.

This makes this important

information instantly available to authorised staff.

**We also use Operoo to send e-forms, excursion forms, permission forms, etc. Operoo allows only one primary owner, who then shares access.

SeeSaw

SeeSaw is a communication app, which is managed by each teacher. They will communicate with you about your child's learning or specific messages for your class.






