Year 5/6s Lifesaving & Beach Safety Program

5/6 PH Recount of Surf Lifesaving - 100 Word Challenge



On Friday 15th of March, 5 / 6's at St. Doms got to learn how to stay safe at the beach by lifeguards!! Firstly, we arrived at Mordialloc Beach after a 30-minute bus ride. After that, we put on our pink rashies from the lifeguards and got sorted into groups. My lifeguard leader was Mia. Firstly we learnt about DRSABCD, then we played beach baseball, then we did flag sprints, and learned about warning signs. After lunch break, we learnt how to rescue people using boogie boards, nipper boards, how to stay safe in a lifejacket, then did a relay with all the things we just learnt, twice. We won the second time!! After we got changed, we went home after the BEST DAY!!!! - Emily

The bright blue salty water splashed in my face. My stomach laid flat on the hard plastic surface of the nipper board. My hands dipped into the water one at a time like a windmill pushing the water with my hands. One by one I flew past people on my board.
